

Treasure Hunt

Ask God, who the treasure (person) is He wants to meet through you today, where this person is, how you will recognize them (for example clothing or features), and what is on their heart. Take your time to listen to Him and write everything down:

Places (bakery, crossroad, bench, cafeteria, gas station, fountain etc.)

Names

Appearance (colour of their clothing, their hair colour etc.)

What do they need prayer for (knee problems, back pain, financial worries, their marriage etc.)

Unusual things (windmill, volleyball, green door, dolphins etc.)





Split in groups of 2-4 people and tell each other, what you have heard. But don't create a combined list. Then go to the places God has told you and watch out to see someone to whom one or more things on your list apply.

When you find the person (treasure) you can say «Hi, this may sound crazy, but you're the treasure we were supposed to find today.» You can show them what you wrote down beforehand and explain how God led you to them. He loves his treasures! This opens the door to great conversations.

You can ask a few questions to get to know them better and you can offer them prayer.

If God moves their heart, ask if you may tell them more about this God who let you to them and share the gospel.

After the conversation you move on to the next place you heard from God.

He even became a human being in Jesus Christ and gave His life for us. He took our place on the cross, bearing all the consequences of sin Himself. Jesus died – but He rose to life again. He offers us peace with God and a personal relationship with Him. Through faith in Jesus, we can experience God's love daily, discover our purpose, and have eternal life after death.	God has already done everything to show us how much He loves us. Through Jesus Christ, He offers us fulfillment and eternal life. We can talk to God directly – we call it "prayer" – to ask for forgiveness for living our lives without Him. We can choose to live with God by trusting Jesus Christ from now on. How will you decide?
